# Children's Church

Our Children's Church program is designed for four to eight year olds so they can enjoy meaningful activities while parents are in the sanctuary for morning services.

Children stay in the sanctuary through the beginning of each service. We feel it is important for them to be involved in the music and fellowship with their families. It also gives them an opportunity to be around other members of the church and our visitors. Right before Brother Gary starts the message, the children will be directed downstairs to their classroom. After the service is over upstairs, come down and see what's going on!
